As a result of years of research, we know that too much animal fat is bad for our health. For example, Americans eat a lot of meat and only a small amount of grain, fruit and vegetable. Because of their diet, they have high rates of cancer and heart disease. In Japan, in contrast, people eat large amounts of grain and very little meat. The Japanese also have very low rates of cancer and heart

disease. In fact, the Japanese live longer than **anyone else** in the world. Unfortunately, when Japanese people move to the United States, the rates of heart disease and cancer increase as their diet changes. Moreover, as hamburgers, ice-cream, and other high fat foods become popular in Japan, the rates of heart disease and cancer are increasing there as well.
